## Objectives and scope

The Youth in Route project aims to address the pressing issue of disaffiliated youth in Belgium, France, Portugal, and Serbia by empowering youth workers to support these individuals in enhancing their prospects in employment, family relationships, sense of initiative, and active citizenship. By implementing both preventive and restorative measures, the partnership believes that it can effectively address the challenges faced by these young individuals and promote their successful reintegration into society, fostering a strong sense of initiative, belonging, and hope for the future. Innovative elements combine traditional methods with modern technology and participatory methodologies.

### Training & EU Capacity Building for Youth Workers

A comprehensive training program covering theoretical insights, practical challenges, and actionable strategies to address youth disaffiliation.



### Youth-Led Digital Incubator

A digital platform providing resources on career opportunities, personal development, and social engagement for marginalized youth.



### Outreach Program for Effective Impact & Sustainability

Community engagement efforts including storytelling circles, media campaigns, and policy dialogues to shift societal perceptions and influence decision-makers.

- Primary target: youth workers and professionals in youth-serving organisations
- Secondary target: disaffiliated youth aged 16-30 in Belgium, France, Portugal, and Serbia, including school and social drop out, and those with migrant background
- Tertiary target: Policy makers, educators, employers, and community leaders
